Auditor General's report and audit opinion

I certify that I have completed the audit of the Annual Return for the year ended 31 March 2024 of **Llanrhaeadr-ym-Mochnant Community Council**. My audit has been conducted on behalf of the Auditor General for Wales and in accordance with the requirements of the Public Audit (Wales) Act 2004 (the 2004 Act) and guidance issued by the Auditor General for Wales.

Audit opinion: Qualified

Except for the matters reported below in my Basis for Qualification, on the basis of my audit, in my opinion no matters have come to my attention to give cause for concern that, in any material respect, the information reported in this Annual Return:

- has not been prepared in accordance with proper practices;
- that relevant legislative and regulatory requirements have not been met;
- is not consistent with the Council's governance arrangements; and
- that the Council does not have proper arrangements in place to secure economy, efficiency and effectiveness in its use of resources.

Basis of Qualification

Accounting Statement

In my opinion, the Accounting Statement does not properly/fairly present the Council's receipts and payments/income and expenditure and financial position:

- The Council's balance carried forward figures (lines 7 and 11) do not equal in the current and prior year periods on the annual return. Lines 7 and 11 must equal. Also, line 7 in the 22-23FY column should equal line 1 in the 23-24FY column.
- The Council has not provided an explanation for the significant variance seen with total other receipts.
- The Council has not provided a properly completed bank reconciliation as at 31 March 2024. The arithmetic of the bank reconciliation is incorrect.

Annual Governance Statement

In my opinion, the Annual Governance Statement is not consistent with the Council's internal controls and governance arrangements for the year:

 Assertion 4: The Council did not advertise the audit and make proper arrangements for the public inspection of accounts as required by the Public Audit (Wales) Act 2004 and the Accounts and Audit (Wales) Regulations 2014).
